Clarify/simplify the meaning: Economic activity contains emission of carbon dioxide from manufactures and using plastics and of methane from foul water and cattle.

Focus on the tenses of the verbs: If we stopped entire current life and business style, CO2 emission could reduce dramatically but world economy would be shrunk and confused.

Clarify the subject/object: For example, it was proved the effects scientifically between decrease of sunspots and decrease of temperature on the earth.

It is true that CO2 emissions also let the temperature rise.

Climate crisis has been told in many ways and we still do not have had much awareness about it.

These problems have began to have a bad influences on our daily life.

Water, solar, geothermal and wind energy don't cause global warming. Also, those energy is basically limitless.
