

# Introduction to Japan Studies

## Grading Rubric

Points are given in the following way. The maximum score is 100. Students are ranked according to their score. Grades are then distributed according to university guidelines for GPA.

### Participation in Class

The default score is 7 points. Points are gained for positive contributions to class. Points are lost for a negative contribution or attitude.

### Active Learning Hours

The Active Learning Hours Report is 2 classes worth of self study (8-10 hours). Submit the report using the sheet provided (the instructions and marking system are in the report sheet).

### Mid-Term Exam

In Week 7 (30 May) there is the Mid-Term Exam. This is a “prepared exam”, in other words, you are given the questions in advance, but you write your answers under exam conditions. The exam questions and marking scheme will be given in Week 4 (9 May). **Note that you must gain a 20 pass score to gain credits for the course as a whole.** People who are absent from or who fail the 30 May exam must retake the exam in Week 14.
